

Opportunity for Public Meeting on Right-of-Way Acquisition from Catawba River Trailhead

Opportunity for Public Meeting Notice to Citizens of York County

All interested persons are advised that the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT), in partnership with York County, proposes to widen Celriver/Red River Road (S-50) in the City of Rock Hill as part of the York County Pennies for Progress Program. The corridor from Eden Terrace Extension to Dave Lyle Blvd is scheduled to be widened from 2 to 5 lanes.

Necessary right-of-way for the project would encroach on the Catawba River Trailhead Park. Specifically, the project would increase the right-of-way easement along the Park by approximately 1.09 acres. However, the road widening project would not adversely impact park use or public access to the park. Based on the project's proposed use of park resources, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) intends to make a de minimis finding for the project. De minimis impacts on publicly owned parks, recreation areas, and wildlife and waterfowl refuges are defined as those that do not "adversely affect the activities, features, and attributes" of the Section 4(f) resources.

Any interested person may request that a public meeting be held on the project with respect to the proposed de minimis finding on the Section 4(f) resource or any possible social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposal on the community. This request must be submitted in writing to Mr. Berry Mattox, SCDOT, P.O. Box 191, Columbia, South Carolina, 29202, and received by SCDOT no later than February 26, 2021. It is requested that your letter contain a telephone number where you may be contacted between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. In the event such a request is received, and a public meeting held, a future notice of the time and place of the meeting will be published. Related maps, drawings, documents, and other pertinent information are available for public review at SCDOT Headquarters, 955 Park Street, Columbia, SC or at York County Government Offices at 6 South Congress Street, Rock Hill, SC.
